## Clinics and BCBUA membership

The BCBUA conducts several forms of clinics for their members.

They include:

Non-Leadoff baseball – 60 foot diamond (often referred to as level 1)	Cost=\$0.00
Lead-off baseball – 70 foot diamond and up (often referred to as Level 2)	Cost = \$0.00
Refresher – for experienced umpires (Level 2 refresher)	Cost = \$0.00
Advanced – for umpires wanting to qualify for Level 3 and subsequently for the National Program.	Cost 2014 = TBA
National – invitation only, for umpires wishing to meet requirements for the National Program.	Cost 2014 = TBA

Two forms of coaches clinics. Cost \$150.00 per clinic irrespective of students.

All clinics listed except the coaches require the students to be members of the BCBUA.

Regular membership for 2014 is \$50.00. Payment of this membership is required for the student to attend a clinic (except coaches). Membership is annual and must be renewed by May 31 or the umpire is not carded.

Youth umpires are discounted to \$25.00. To qualify for this, an umpire must be 13 or under as of Dec. 31 of the current year.

If an umpire wishes to attend more than one clinic, the appropriate membership applicable to the age of the umpire must be paid, but it need be paid only once. Individual clinic fees – if applicable – would need to be paid.
