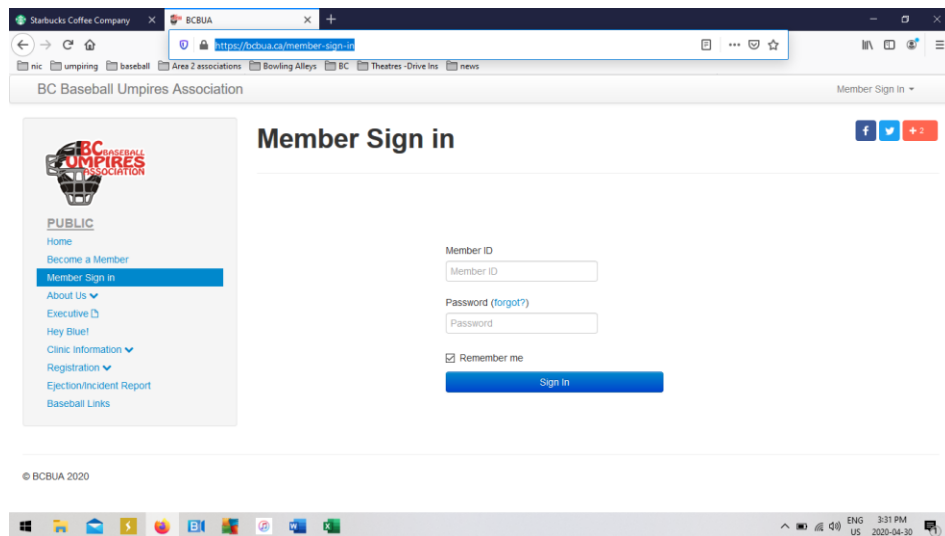


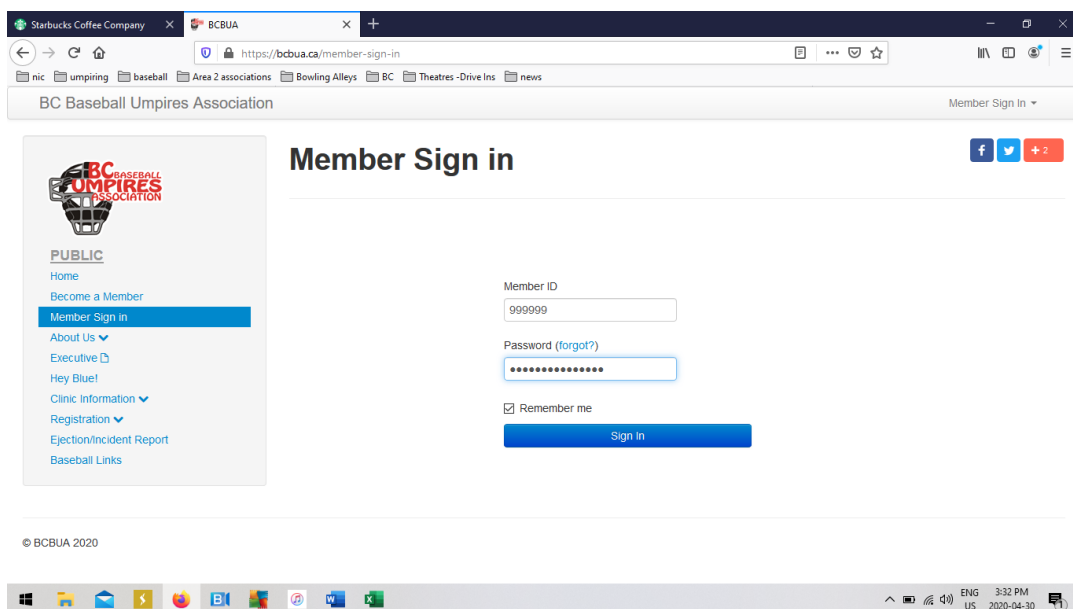
Accessing Level 1, 2, and 3 Digital Clinics and Education Resources

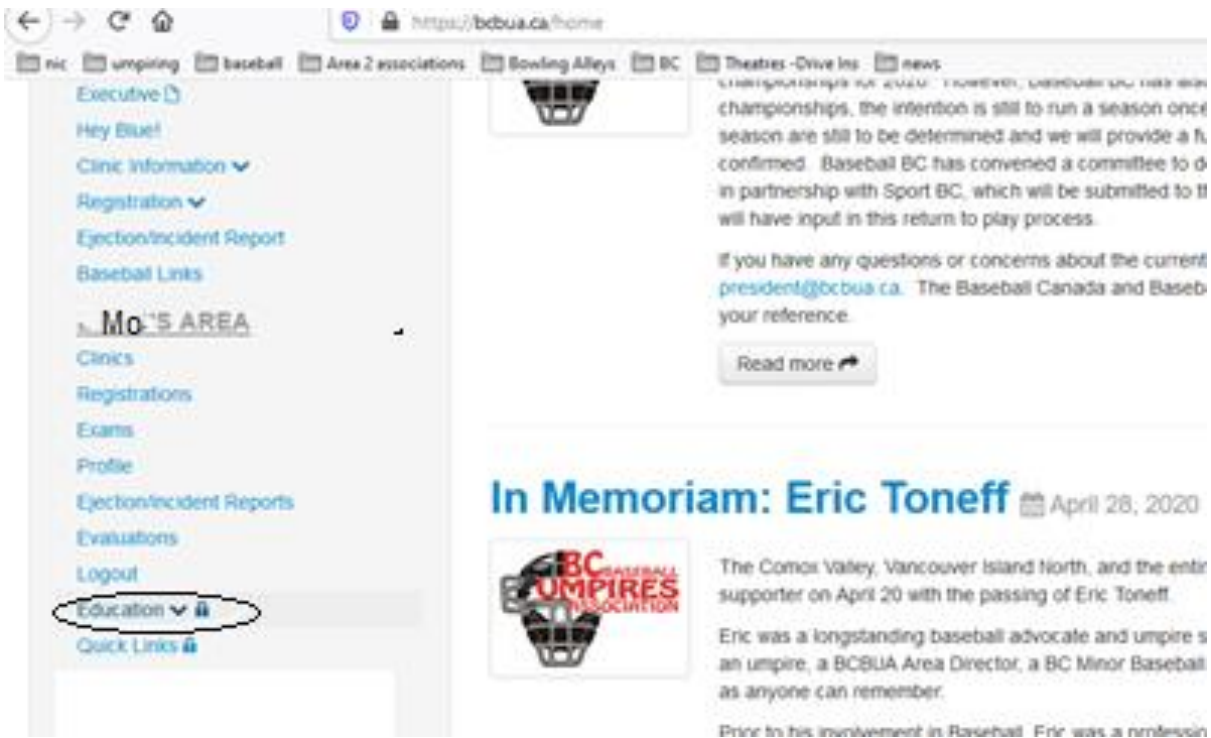
1. Go to BCBUA member sign-in page: <https://bcbua.ca/member-sign-in>



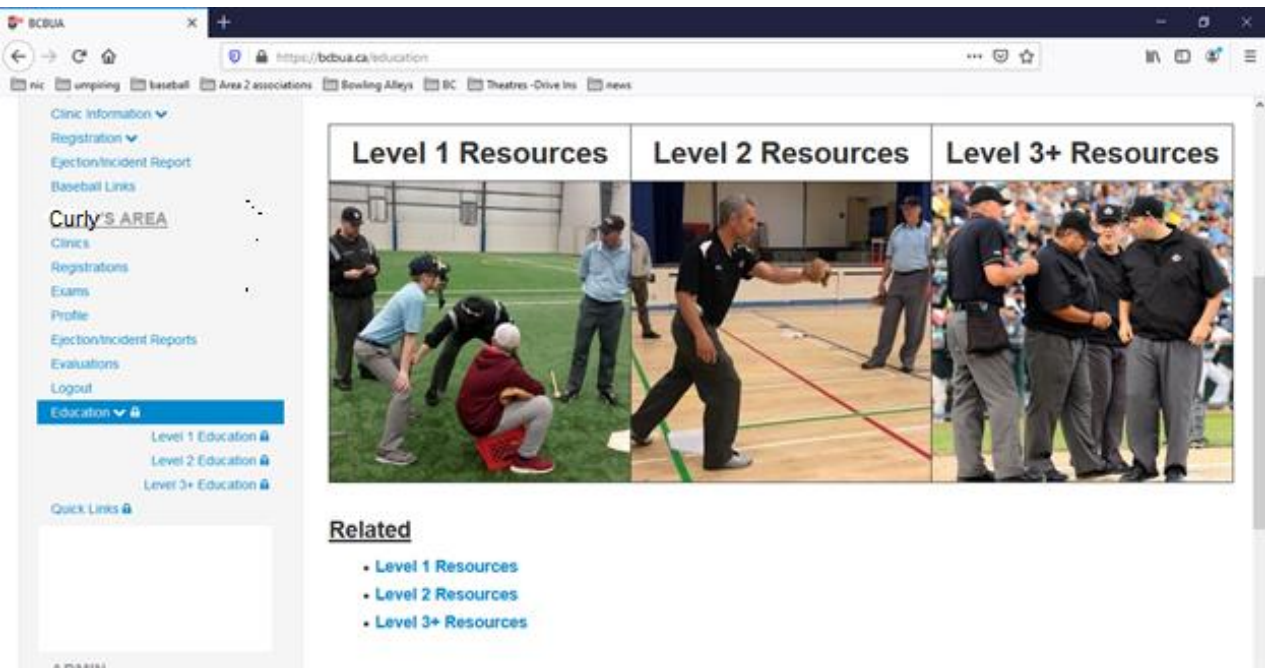
2. Type in your id number and password to access your account. Click the Sign-in button.



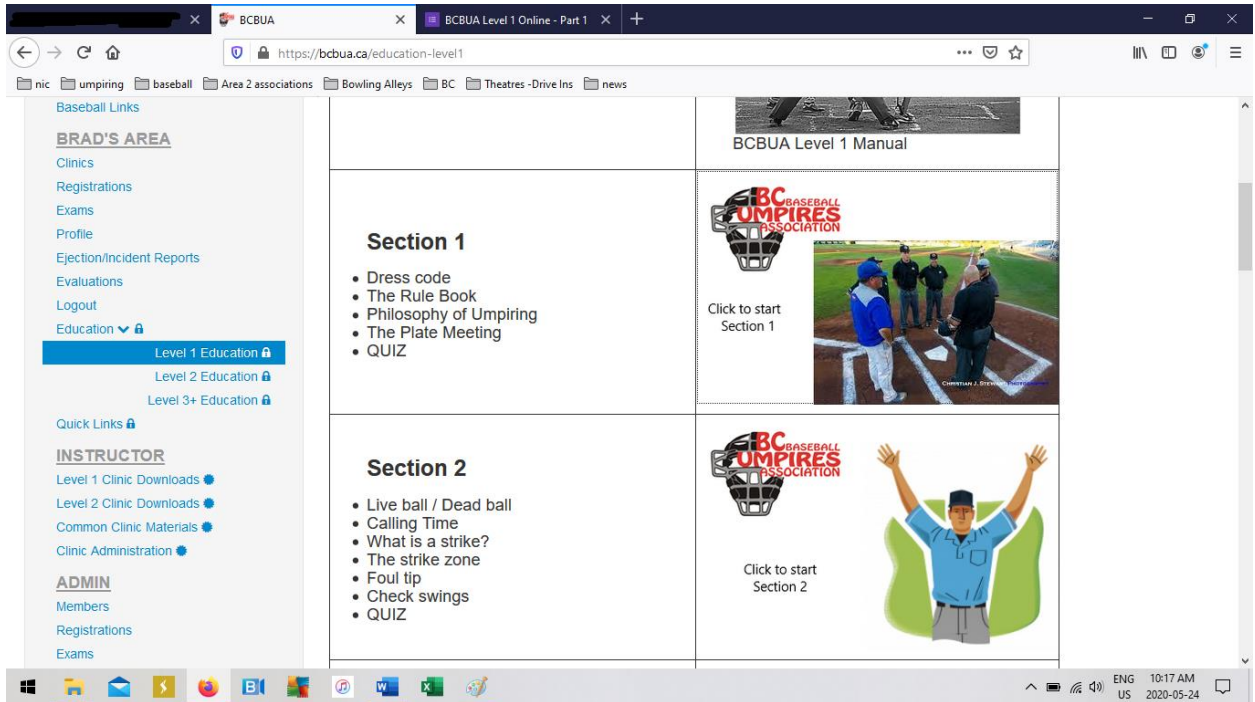
3. Under your Area: click on the education Link



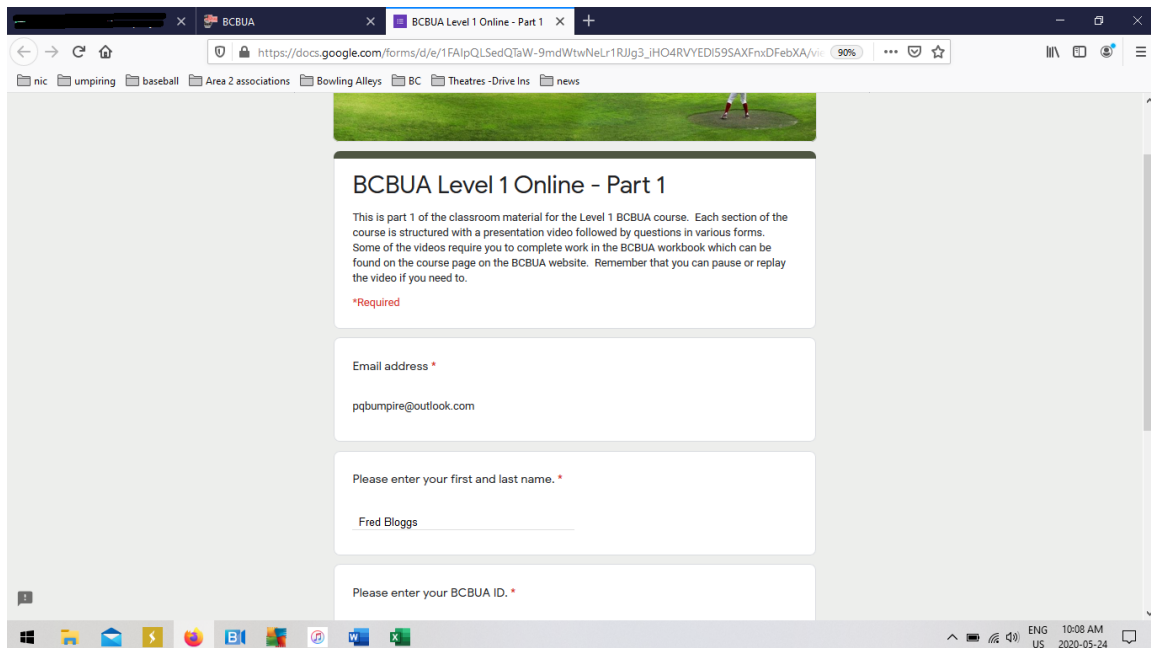
4. Click on the Level you are to access the resources

6. Sign-in to each section then follow through the module, building on knowledge of previous modules.



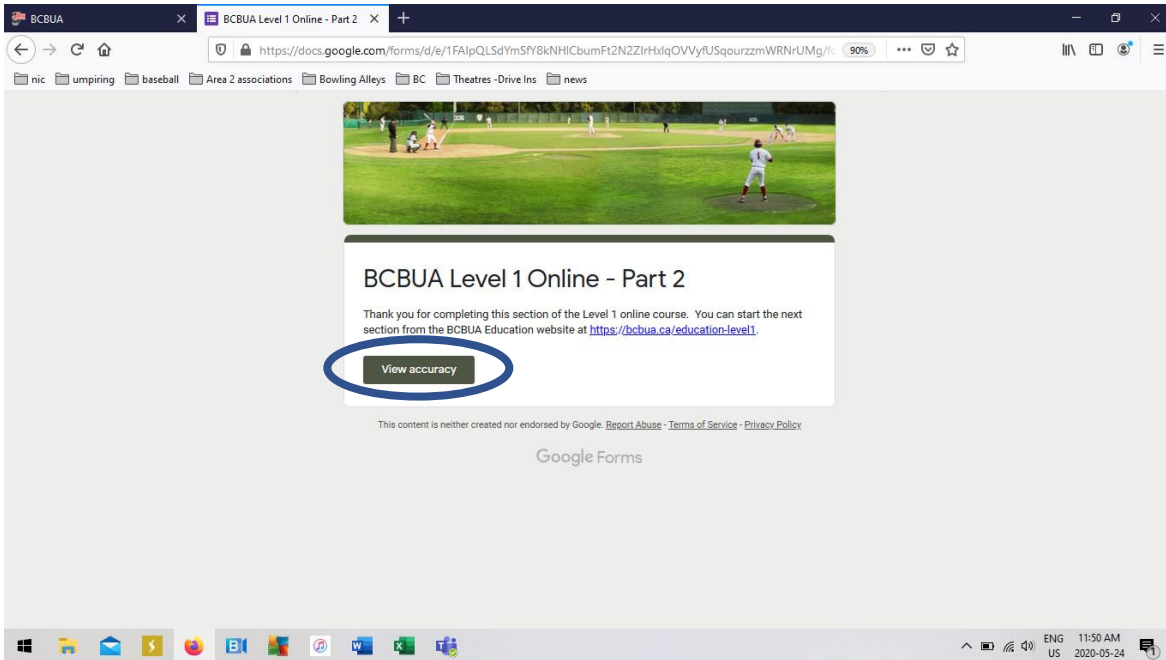
7. Watch the video. Once it is over, scroll down and fill out the section quiz.

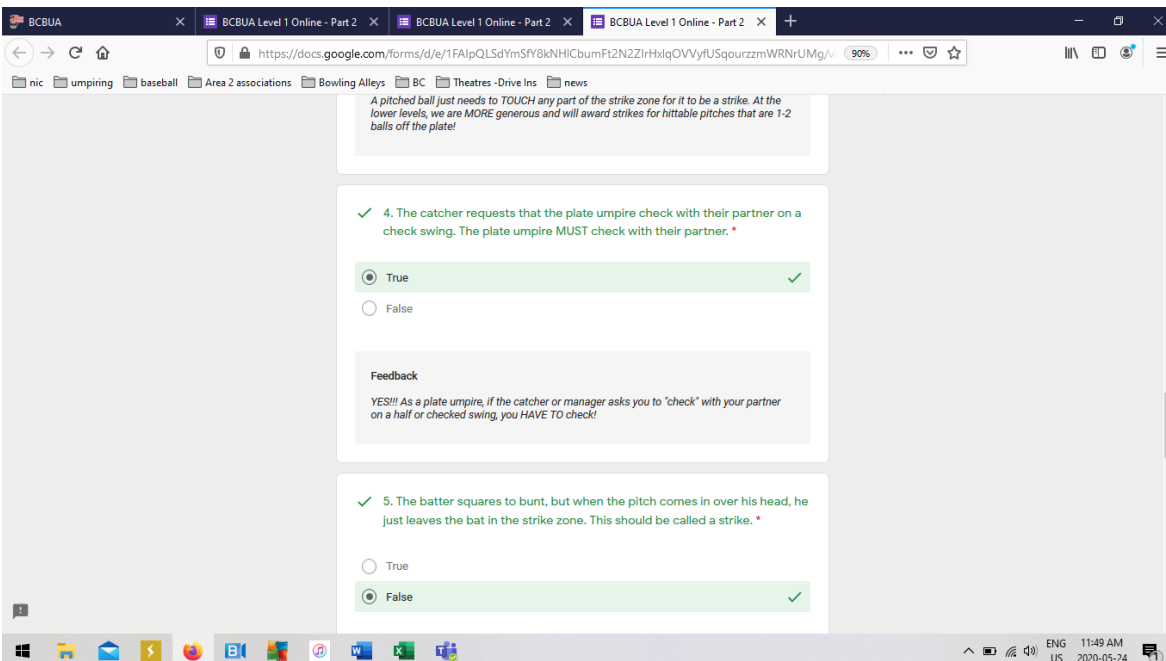
8. Once you have finished the section quiz, click Submit.
