# Safe Sport Education & Orientation Policy

### (1.0) Introduction

The BCBUA believes in fostering a safe, welcoming, and inclusive environment for participants. The purpose of this policy is to document a process for how participants will be educated and oriented on BCBUA Safe Sport policies.

# (2.0) Application

This policy shall apply to all members of the BCBUA.

# (3.0) Annual Education & Orientation

All members of the BCBUA will receive an <u>annual</u> Safe Sport orientation email. The email will include:

- A link to the BCBUA's online Safe Sport page (which will include links to the BCBUA's Safe Sport policies)
- Highlight any changes in policy
- Provide clarity and explanation on policies, as determined by the President
- Information on how to report Safe Sport concerns

### (4.0) Event Specific Education & Orientation

In advance of participating in any baseball event directly organized by the BCBUA, umpires will be emailed reminders of specific policies, as determined applicable. An example of such an email, would be sending umpires, travelling to an out-of-town camp, a copy of the Travel Policy, prior to their departure.
